



WOODLANDS CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

The Settlement:

On July 7, 2010, the British Columbia Supreme Court approved a settlement of a class action for people who lived at Woodlands. This was a residential facility in New Westminster, British Columbia for children and adults with mental disabilities.

The settlement provides compensation of between \$3,000 and \$150,000 to each former resident who establishes that he or she was subjected to sexual, physical, or psychological misconduct or injury while living at Woodlands on or after August 1, 1974. Money is also available for counseling for these injuries.

Class Members who validly opted out of the class action on or before December 22, 2008, are not part of the settlement.

Deadline:

To be eligible for compensation, the Class Member, or someone acting on their behalf, must complete a claim form. The completed claim form must be delivered or postmarked to the Woodlands Class Action Claims Registry, #300 - 1275 West 6th Avenue, Vancouver, BC, V6H 1A6, by no later than **September 19, 2011**.
