NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT APPROVAL HEARING

If you or someone close to you used Premarin with progestin or Premplus and later developed breast cancer, this notice may affect your legal rights.

A hearing has been scheduled on April 2, 2015 at 10am at the courthouse in Vancouver before the Supreme Court of British Columbia to review and consider a proposed class action settlement in *Stanway* v. *Wyeth Canada Inc.*, *et al.* The court will be asked to determine whether the proposed settlement should be approved as fair and reasonable and in the best interests of class members.

Who is Eligible for the Proposed Settlement?

To be eligible to participate in this proposed settlement you must be a member of the class, or the estate or legal representative of a class member, and if you are not a resident of British Columbia, you must have already delivered an opt-in form in the lawsuit, on or before October 10, 2014.

The class is defined as:

"Women who were prescribed Premplus, or Premarin in combination with progestin during the Class Period and ingested Premplus, or Premarin in combination with progestin and were thereafter diagnosed with breast cancer."

The "Class Period" runs from January 1, 1977 until December 1, 2003, inclusive.

What are the Terms of the Settlement?

You can obtain a copy of the settlement agreement by contacting Class Counsel at the address below. In summary, the Defendants agreed to pay compensation to settle the allegations in the lawsuit. This money is available to compensate class members, and to pay public health insurers for their subrogated costs, as well as to pay legal fees and expenses related to the prosecution of this class action.

How Do I Participate in the Approval Hearing?

If you agree with the proposed settlement, you do not have to do anything at this time. If the settlement is approved by the court, class members will be notified as to the procedures for submitting a claim for compensation under the settlement.

If you disagree with the proposed settlement, you have the right to object. You may do so by delivering a letter to Class Counsel in advance of the hearing which Class Counsel will then provide to the court. In your written objection, you should provide your name, contact information and a brief statement of the nature and reasons for your objection.
